Dear Residents:

Thank you to everyone who attended the 22nd Annual Halloween party it was a beautiful evening. After review of the current rate structure for both water and sewer and due to the rising costs of living the Village will be raising water rates effective this months bill. The water rates will be increasing from \$6.25 per 1,000 gallons to \$7.75 per 1,000 gallons. Some Villages increase rates yearly and we have not since 2009. The increase break down is as follows: we pay \$2.56 to JAWA per 1,000 gallons and \$.91 per 1,000 gallons is paid to the Village of Round Lake Beach.
