### **GROOT YARD WASTE PICK UP**

Yard Waste Pickup will begin on Friday, April 6, 2018 and run through November 16, 2018. All yard waste must be bagged in a brown paper lawn bag or 32 gallon can.

Pick-up is on Friday mornings and such containers shall be placed on the parkway adjoining such premises within ten (10) hours before garbage pickup and shall be removed there from within ten (10) hours after the pickup service is rendered.

***Please do not rake leaves to the side of the road as leaf pick up is in the fall. All leaves that you need picked up earlier are to be bagged and tagged with yard waste stickers.***
